On the 20.04.2005 we were awarded the fourth prize from the German Children and Youth Trust for Education and Research for our All day School Work. A day before all prize winners met and were asked to consider how they were going to introduce themselves. We remarked: "We are the webs of Bargteheide and we web the net".

It is correct, we have discovered that the networks were an extreme advantage for our exchangeable thinking. A net will be our symbol on the cover of our next school program. We gave practical ideas of a successful all day work at schools. Out of more than 200 participating schools nationwide, the last 20 were invited to Berlin. The Minister of Education Edelgard Bulmann awarded the prize winners. The Minister emphasized how our school managed a successful cooperation between school and youth work. The headmistress Angelika Knies, the social worker Joachim Brodmann from Bargteheide council and four members of the school representatives – Elena Böcker, Aylin Wemper, Malia Winkler and Sophia Vazouras took the prize – a digital videocamera and a cheque of 500 €.

"We are very happy that we managed to come so far. We see this as a confirmation of our All day concept and also the work of the youth team from Bargteheide and as a motivation for the future", said Angelika Knies. "The cheque we will use to develop our concept – especially in view of developing the quality of our teaching lessons. This will be decided finally by our organizing group "Reformpädagogik". Joachim Brodmann remarked the communication between the schools during the two days in Berlin. "There were many ideas which we can use in our concept.". And the students were amazed and proud of their school the two days in Berlin.
